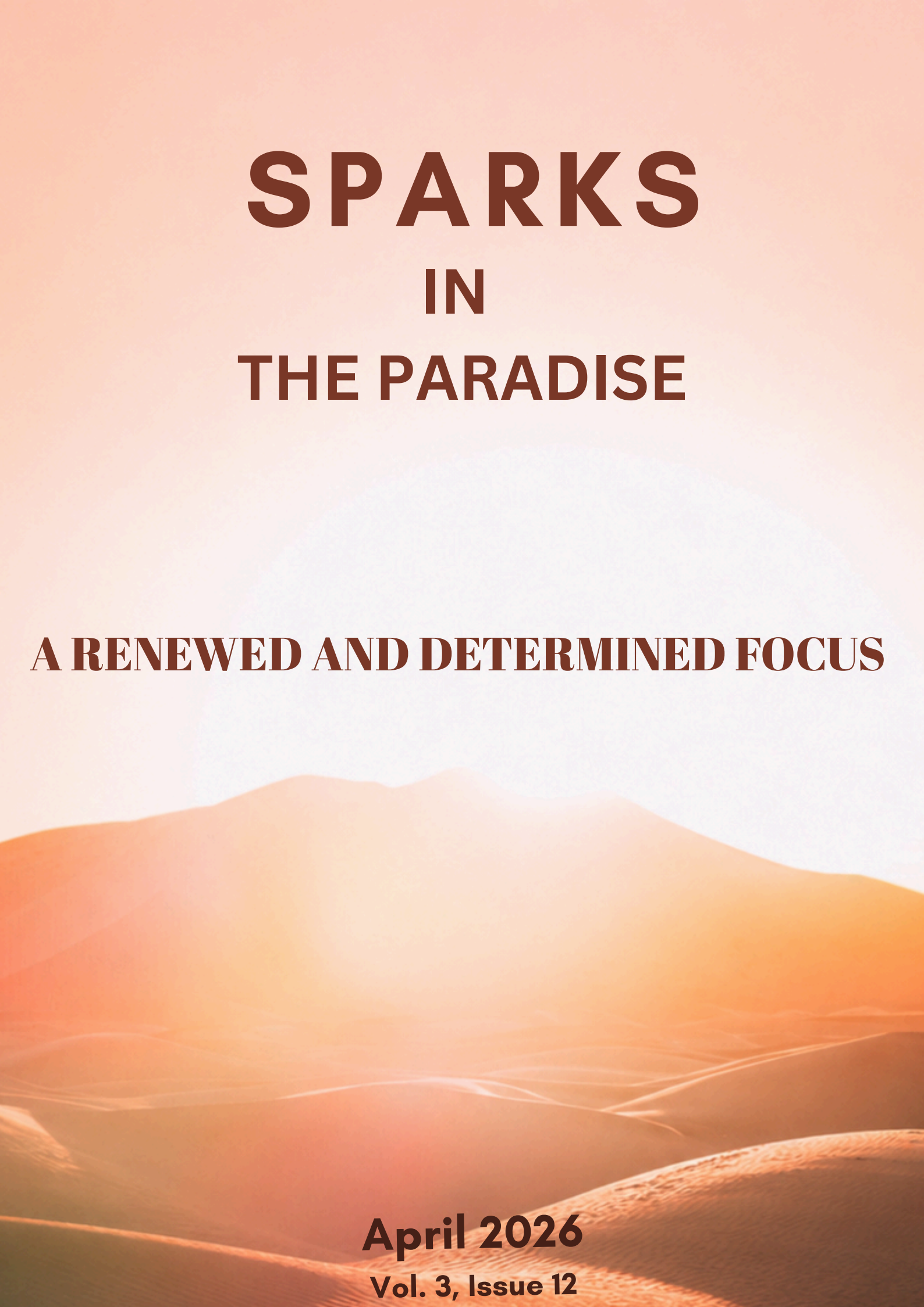

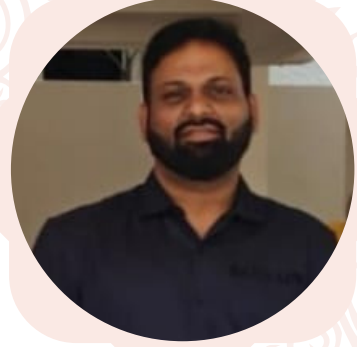
The time is now, the day is today! Let us take forward with a determined focus.

This is the best and most enthusiastic school I have ever studied in.

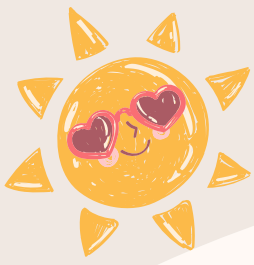

At the same time, it is important to take care of health and safety during the hot weather.

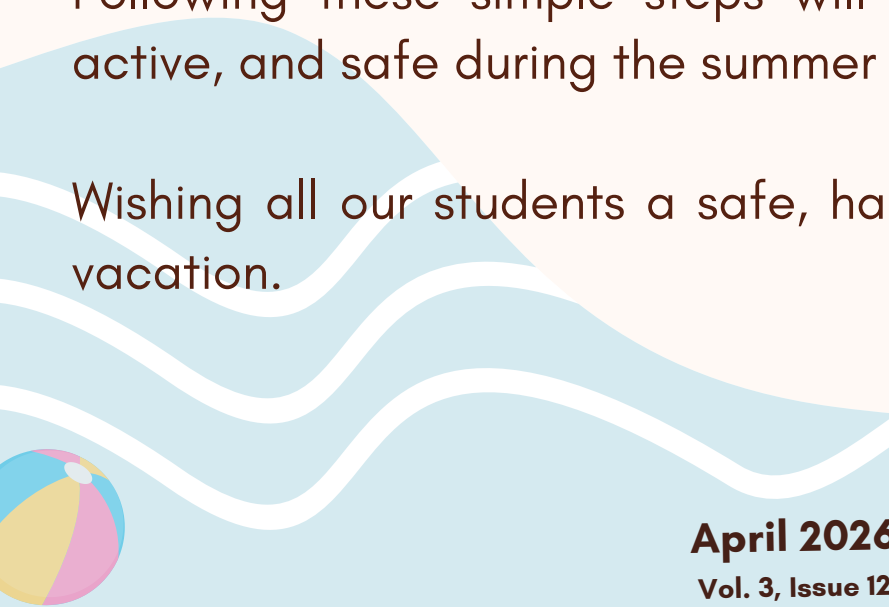
Students are advised to follow some simple safety tips:
